

2019-20 Temple University Financial Aid Timeline for Entering Students & Their Families

Deadlines, time frames, and resources for critical financial aid information such as when to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), deadline to submit financial aid requirements and when students can expect to view a financial aid award letter.

Search for Scholarships: You will **automatically** be considered for Academic Merit Scholarship from Undergraduate Admissions. Other options from outside sources may be available, but knowing where to look is key. Remember; **never pay anyone to do a scholarship search** for you ([Search Resource](#)). Students can continue their scholarship search year round.

Your FAFSA is Due! **March 1st** is the priority FAFSA filing deadline for all students to ensure consideration for **need-based** grant funding.

Review the **Costs & Aid** tab of your **TUportal account** – complete all **Financial Aid requirements** and create an estimated bill using the University's **Tuition Calculator**.

Create **authorized payers** in the **TUpay system** – this way they receive the e-bill notification along with the student.

Research additional loan options if needed.

Tuition and Housing Deposit Deadline is May 1st, 2019. **Submit your enrollment and/or Housing deposit now!**

Deadline to submit **all Financial Aid requirements** – requirements will be accepted after June 1st, however **need-based grant** awarded funding is **no longer guaranteed**.

Fall classes begin Monday August 26th.

Financial aid disbursements begin processing for eligible students **Thursday August 22nd** and continue to process daily.

OCTOBER

Submit **FAFSA** to Temple University (**school code 003371**) through fafsa.gov.

NOVEMBER

2

Deadline for Temple University **Admission application** for Academic Merit Scholarship consideration! Applications are accepted past **February 1st**, however academic merit scholarship funding could be exhausted.

3

FEBRUARY

Financial Aid award letters are available beginning mid-February for all entering freshman & transfer students.

MARCH

4

Learn about the Temple University **financial aid** and **billing** processes.

5

APRIL

Review **FERPA wavier** information- the SFS Office cannot share student account information without student consent.

APRIL - MAY

6

The **State Grant** for **PA Residents** application is also due May 1st (pheaa.org).

7

MAY

Apply for additional loan funding for upcoming 2019-20 academic year: **Federal Parent PLUS Loan** and/or **Private Student Loan**.

JUNE

8

Fall 2019 e-bill is processed for all enrolled students - check **TU Pay** and pay your bill.

9

JULY

Sign up for **Direct Deposit!**
