

2020-21 Temple University Financial Aid Timeline for Incoming Students & Their Families

Deadlines, time frames, and resources for critical financial aid information such as when to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), deadline to submit financial aid requirements and when students can expect to view a financial aid award offer.

Sign up for [Direct Deposit](#) and create [authorized payers](#) in [TUpay](#) – this way authorized payers receive the e-bill notification along with the student. [Fall 2020 e-bill](#) is processed for all enrolled students beginning **7/20/2020** - check [TU Pay](#) to pay your bill.

Apply for additional loan funding for upcoming 2020-21 academic year: [Federal Parent PLUS Loan](#) and/or [Private Student Loan](#).

Fall 2020 account balance is due 9/10/2020. Students with outstanding account balances after this date will be automatically enrolled in Temple's [Deferred Payment Plan](#).

Spring 2021 account balance processed **12/9/2020** for students registered for Spring 2021.

Priority Deadline for the 2021-2022 FAFSA application is 2/1/2021. FAFSA applications must be complete, signed, and submitted by priority deadline to be considered for any need based grant funding. Monitor TU Portal for any outstanding financial aid requirements.

Search for Scholarships: Remember; **never pay anyone to do a scholarship search** for you ([Search Resource](#)). Students can also utilize iGrad, which has an outside scholarship search tool. The link to iGrad is on the Cost and Aid tab of TU Portal.



Review the **Costs & Aid** tab of your **TUportal** account – complete all [Financial Aid requirements](#) for the 2020-21 FAFSA and create an estimated bill using the University's [Tuition Calculator](#).

Earliest date that fall 2020 aid will begin to disburse is **8/20/2020**. Fall classes begin **8/24/2020**.

All financial aid requirements and enrollment requirements must be met for financial aid to disburse.

The **2021-2022 FAFSA** application opens **10/1/2020**. Temple University recommends students submit FAFSA applications as early as possible to meet our priority deadline. The 2021-22 FAFSA tax information is based off of the 2019 tax year.

Spring 2021 account balance is due **1/30/21**. Students with outstanding account balances after this date will be automatically enrolled in the [Deferred Payment Plan](#).

Check with your academic program for any departmental scholarship applications for the 2021-2022 academic year.

Make sure **all financial aid requirements on 2021-2022 FAFSA are complete by 6/1/2021**.

Continuing student financial aid offers for the 2021-22 academic year will be available beginning in late June.

Official 2021-2022 tuition rates will be released in mid-July 2021.
